- Guarantee the tranquillity of naturist holidaymakers whilst also organising sporting or cultural activities for those who desire them.
- We will not tolerate any voyeurism or exhibitionism which could upset children or adults.
- Inform holidaymakers ways in which they can enjoy naturism throughout the year by introducing them to the national and international network: Clubs, Associations, Federations.
- Respect and preserve nature, protect the environment by encouraging economy of energy and water.
